- Class 1 Boys under 21 1/1/11 Shoot 10m one handed, ride over junior course
with some bigger fences max approx 1m, run 1500m, swim 4mins
- Class 2 Girls Under 21 1/1/11 Shoot 10m one handed, ride as above
run 1500m, swim 3 mins
- Class 3 Boys under 15 years on 1/1/11 Shoot 7m one handed,
ride max 90cm, run 1500m, swim 3 mins
- Class 4 Girls under 15 years on 1/1/11 as class 3
- Class 5 Boys Under 12 years on 1/1/11 (Min age 8 years), Shoot 7m
two handed, ride 76cm max, run 1000m, swim 2 mins
- Class 6 Girls under 12 years on 1/1/11 (Min age 8 years) as class 5
- Class 7 Mini-mini Boys Under 10 yrs on 1/1/11 small enclosed ride max
60cm (no leading reins) Run 1000 m, swim 2 mins , 7m two hands
- Class 8 Mini-mini girls under 10 years as above
- Class 9 Mini mini Tri boy/girls under 8 years on 1/1/11 small fences in

Terms & Conditions;

Teams will consist of 3 or 4 competitors, best 3 scores to count. Individuals may be made up into teams.

Guns must be kept in their cases AT ALL TIMES and may ONLY be taken out to place on the shoot table when instructed to do so by the *shoot steward*.

Loaders must be over the age of 18 years

No horse may be ridden more than twice. If a horse is to be ridden twice in the same class the *collecting ring steward* must be informed before the start of that class. Outside assistance at the slip rail will be penalised as the rule book with the exception of Classes 7 & 8 where the fence judge considers in the interest of safety a pony should be held at the slip rail.

Crash hats , medical arm bands and back/body protectors as per Tetrathlon Rule Book must be worn at all times when mounted.

The course will be open for walking from 12.00 noon Friday 10th September 2011

Shoot details will be available from the event Secretary (SAE please), or phone 01825 740435 from Thursday 8th Sept. Competitors will ride & run in numerical order.

Objections should be made by *team managers* only to the the *Phase Steward* or *Event Organiser*.

Sussex Medical Services will be on duty during the riding phase. A veterinary surgeon will be on call during the riding phase.

Refreshments will be available at Carewell on 10th Sept and the cafeteria will be open at the Edenbridge Leisure Centre during the swimming phase
